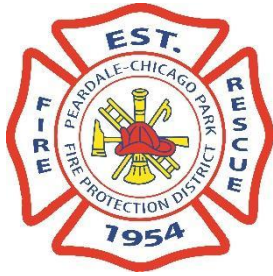

PEARDALE-CHICAGO PARK FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

Fire Captain

The Peardale-Chicago Park Fire Protection District is seeking applications to fill a position of Fire Captain. The position will be full-time, 51 hours/week (Sun.-Wed.), 7am-7pm, Wednesday evening training 7pm-10pm.

Hourly compensation range is \$27.10-\$32.96 per hour, including 11 paid Holidays. Employees earn 96 hours of sick leave and 80 hours of vacation leave (120 hours after 5 years) per calendar year. CalPERS Retirement is 2% @ 57; Health insurance allowance, \$1000/month; Dental & Vision allowance, \$1200/year; Uniform allowance, \$800/year; \$100,000 Life Insurance provided. Probation period is for one year.

- CPAT, current within one year
- Qualified to operate all District emergency vehicles
- California State Fire Marshal Driver/Operator 1A/1B
- National Wildland Coordinating Group Engine Boss
- Basic Computer and writing skills
- Minimum four (4) years full-time paid firefighting experience with two years at, or above, the rank of Fire Apparatus Engineer
- California State Fire Marshal Fire Officer Certification

Duties and Responsibilities:

Shall respond to incidents in appropriate district equipment. Shall react quickly and calmly in emergency situations. Shall have knowledge of monthly reporting and information gathering; be familiar with district policies and operational procedures and guidelines. Shall have working knowledge of district budget and purchasing procedures. Shall understand all aspects of fire suppression, fire prevention

emergency planning and emergency medical services and the professional management of all resources in accomplishing this mission.

Assume responsibilities of Chief in his/her absence.

Assume Incident Commander at incidents under District jurisdiction unless relieved by an Officer of equal or higher rank.

Assist Chief in developing yearly/long range goals, budget, policies, and guidelines.

Assist in apparatus design and equipment purchase/replacement.

Attend training and seminars to keep current with issues relevant to the Fire District.

Conduct safety and vegetation inspections of residential and commercial properties.

Provide training opportunities for Paid Call Firefighters.

Perform routine equipment and apparatus maintenance.

Perform building and grounds maintenance and minor construction projects.

Maintain department logs relative to scheduled maintenance.

Identify and remove from service, equipment needing repair or replacement.

All other duties as assigned.

Supervision

Shall be supervised by the Fire Chief.

Shall have supervision responsibilities for all Paid Call Firefighters.

Examination process will consist of both written examinations and oral interviews.

Application packets will be accepted no later than April 23, 2021 at 1700 hours. Packets may also be hand-delivered to Fire Station 57. All application packages must be received by the deadline. No postdates or facsimiles will be accepted. Incomplete submissions will not be accepted.
